

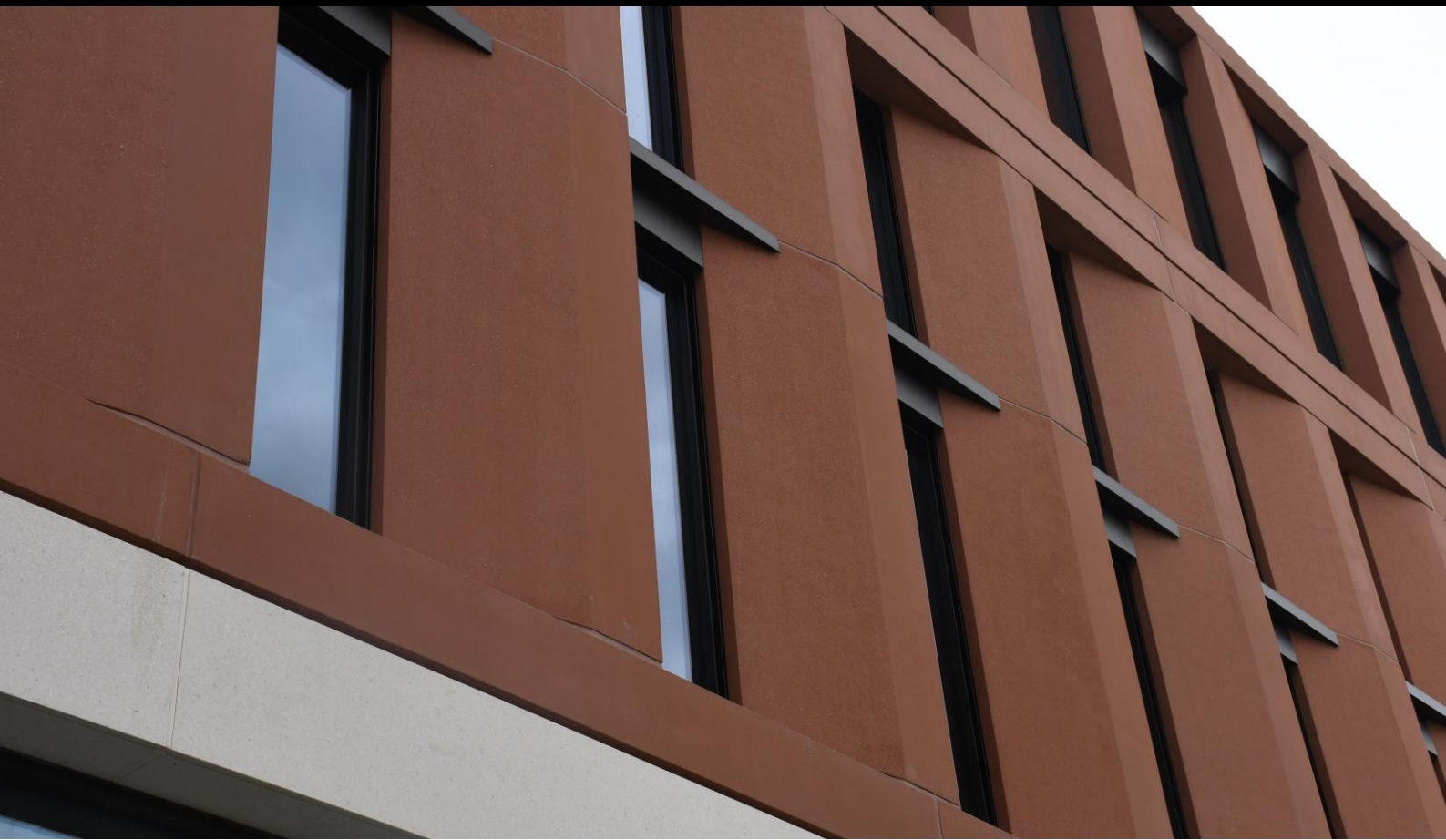

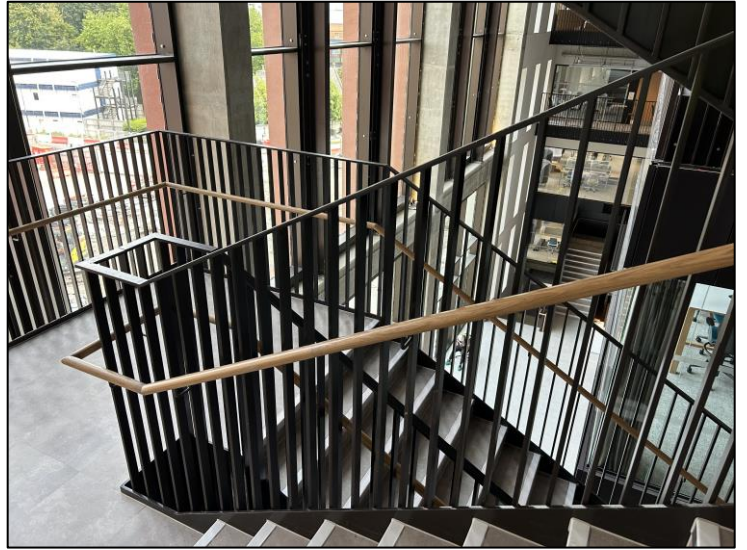


## Welcome to our August update

### Project Look Ahead

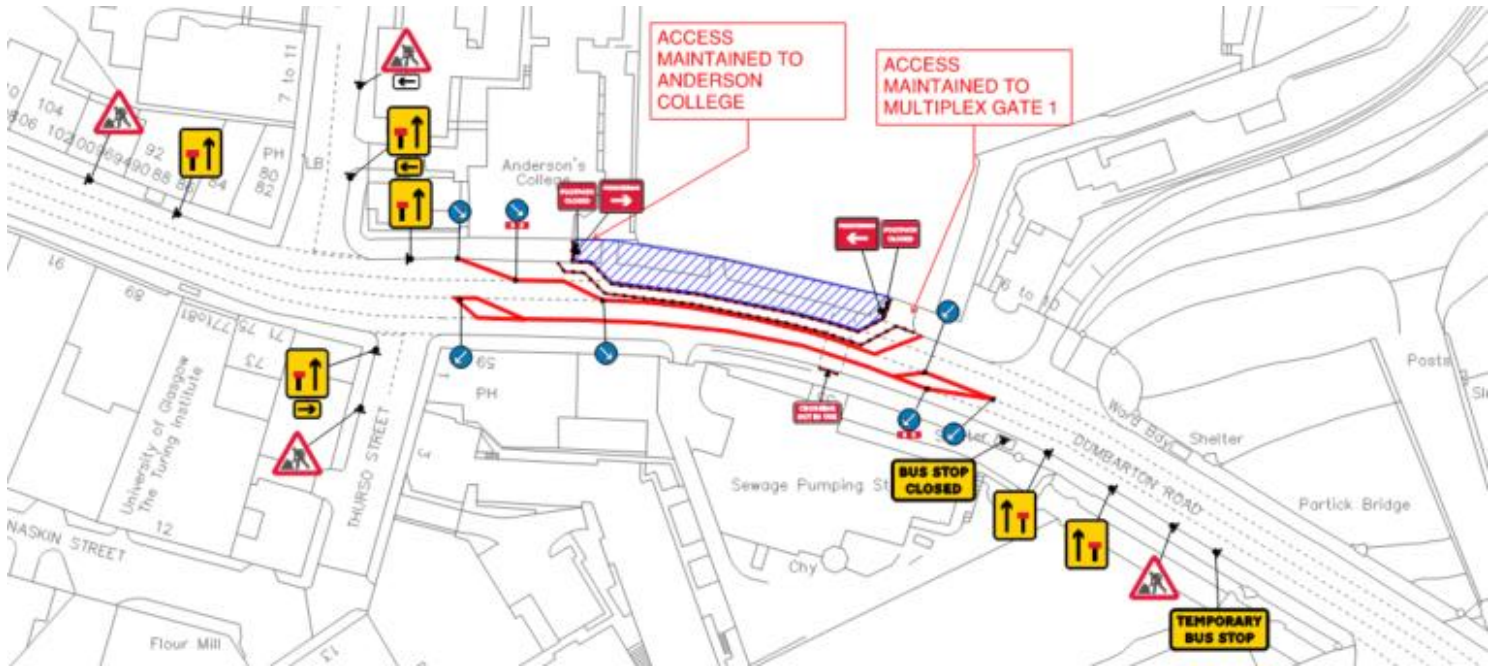
- The University will continue with their furniture installation and staff familiarisation prior to full occupation.

### Creating **positive impact**

A number of planned post-completion works will continue over the coming months:

- The Café area design will be finalised before the fitout commences
- Additional offices will be configured into the floorplate on level 6
- The hard landscaping at the south of the site will be completed

## Community Update



*Temporary pavement and lane occupation markup*

- To facilitate the remaining hard landscaping works at the southern end of the site, a temporary lane closure and extension of the hoarding line will be in place, with pedestrian access maintained throughout.
- These works are scheduled to be completed by the end of September at which point the lane and pavement will be fully reinstated.
- The landscaping will compliment the high-quality finishes evident throughout the completed areas of the site and create a welcoming community space leading to St. Mungo's Square.

## What's Next?

- Multiplex have been awarded an enabling works package that will facilitate the next phase of the overall masterplan. This includes demolition of the Western Infirmary Lecture Theatre (WILT) and Admin buildings amongst other preparatory works.
- A design team have been appointed by the University and have been working closely with representatives from a number of disciplines to develop concept designs for the next building on the former Western Infirmary site.
- The next plot to be developed is sited directly opposite the Advanced Research Centre (ARC) and will be of a similar scale.
- More details on these plans will be released in future publications.
